



North Shields and the Fish Quay

Year One Summer Term, 2021

This term Year One will be learning all about North Shields and the Fish Quay and of course we will be incorporating some work on pirates.

English - The children will continue to work on increasing their vocabulary and their grammar whilst writing a message in a bottle, a job application to become a pirate, a diary entry in role as a pirate, creating their own story and much more!

Maths - We will be working on multiplication, division and fractions. We will have lots of fun practising position and direction using pirate maps to help. We will continue our work on place value working with numbers up to 100 and finish the year working with money and learning to tell the time.

Science - The children will enjoy some outdoor learning looking closely at both house plants and wild plants. We will grow some magic beans and investigate what plants need to survive. We will also participate in exciting experiments where they will be 'working scientifically'.

Geography - We will be designing our own treasure maps, using a map of the school to find hidden treasure and looking at the human and physical geography of our local area.

Art and DT - We will be creating our own pirate flags, desert islands, treasure chests and much more!

Music - We will continue our work on Sing Up and try some different instruments.

PE - The children will be doing dance and athletics and will also be taking part in team games.

RE - We will continue our work on Christianity and investigate the Jewish faith.

History - The children will learn about the history of our local area, and investigate whether any pirates have ever visited our shores!

ICT - In ICT we will be concentrating on e-safety and recognising common uses of ICT beyond school.
