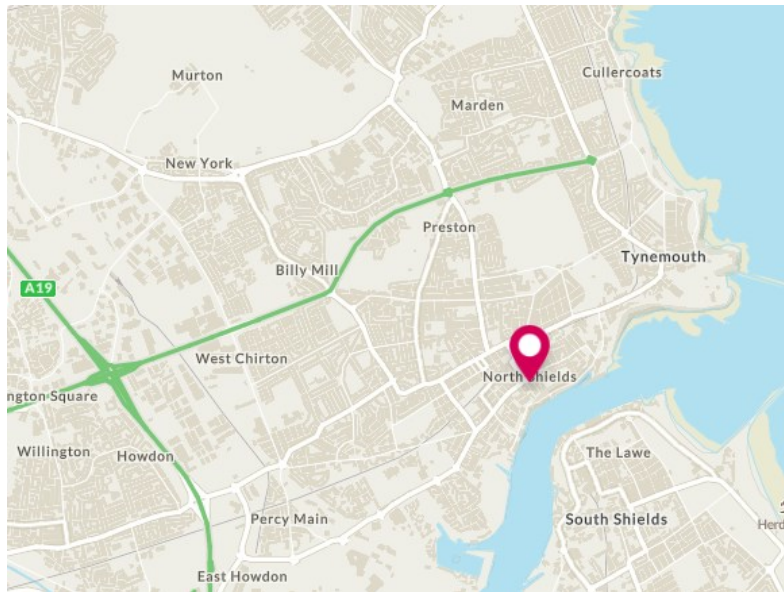


Mapping North Shields: how is North Shields represented on maps?



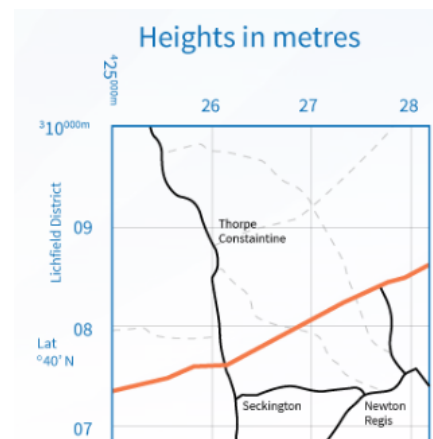
Key questions

Key vocab

- CBD (central business district) - part of town which contains main commercial streets and public buildings
- Human features - things that are made or built by humans
- Urban— geographical area inside towns and cities
- Ordnance Survey— a map which shows physical and human features as symbols



OS maps are divided into squares. These squares are known as a grid and they help to locate features within them. Every square on an OS map is the same as a square kilometre.
