### Key vocabulary

**Continent** a large land mass, there are 7 in all.

**Country** land that is controlled by a single government

**Capital city** where the government functions

**Population** the total number of people living in a country

**Ocean** a body of water

**Atlas** geography guide containing facts about every country in the world

**Globe** a sphere on which a map is represented

**Map** a drawing of all parts of the world
