Each family will be able to have 2 tickets, this will give us a maximum of 50 in the hall so we can socially distance. Tickets will be available in November from the class teachers. The performances will also be recorded and shared on SeeSaw and google classroom (permission slips will be collected).

EYFS, Year 1 and 2, Year 3 and 4, Year 5 and 6 will all have their own party. We will provide the food and entertainment , so all the children need is a set of party clothes to get changed into.

Non-Uniform Christmas Accessory day

Children to come into school in non-uniform but are welcome to wear a Christmas accessory. This could be tinsel around their head— it does not have to be fancy and is not essential! Throughout the day the children will make their own Christmas accessories that they can wear that day and even during their Christmas Party.
