adorable	someone or something inspiring great affection or delight
changeable	someone or something that is able to be changed or exchanged

portable	something that is able to be easily carried or moved, especially because being of a lighter and smaller version than usual
available	someone or something that is not otherwise occupied; free to do something
suitable	right or appropriate for a particular person, purpose, or situation
forgivable	something that is able to be forgiven or tolerated; excusable
enjoyable	something that gives delight or pleasure
comfortable	(especially of clothes or furnishings) providing physical ease and relaxation
reasonable	having sound judgement; fair and sensible

dependable	trustworthy and reliable
forgettable	easily forgotten, especially through being uninteresting or mediocre
inflatable	- capable of being filled with air - a plastic or rubber object that must be filled with air before use
laughable	so funny or ludicrous as to be amusing
inevitable	certain to happen; unavoidable
unshakeable	(of a belief, feeling, or opinion) strongly felt and unable to be changed, disputed or questioned
knowledgeable	intelligent and well informed
understandable	- able to be understood - to be expected; natural, reasonable, or forgivable
despicable	deserving hatred and contempt
considerable	- notably large in size, amount, or extent - a person having merit or distinction
foreseeable	able to be foreseen or predicted
desirable	wished for as being an attractive, useful, or necessary course of action; advantageous
justifiable	able to be shown to be right or reasonable; defensible
regrettable	someone's conduct or an event giving rise to regret; undesirable; unwelcome
